

### Oh no! This boat is full!

Help your child make a boat that can stand up.



### Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

## FULL BOAT

### You will need:

- copy of activity instructions
- crayons, textas, coloured pencils, etc.
- thin cardboard 6cm x 28cm (use a cereal box)
- scissors
- gluestick
- tape
- 1 pipecleaner

### Instructions

1. Colour in the animals and cut out.
2. Cut a strip of cardboard 6cm x 28cm and glue to the back of the boat. Fold along the dotted lines and stand the boat up.
3. Glue the animals into the boat.
4. Tape a small piece of pipecleaner (approx. 6cm) to the back of the mouse. Tape the other end to the back of the cow's head.

### An idea to simplify this activity.

Cut out the various pieces.

Cut the boat away from the base strip. Discard base strip.

Glue the animal and boat pieces together onto a piece of blue coloured paper.

Draw fish and waves onto the blue background.
